Including songs from *The Phantom of the Opera*, *Les Misérables*, *Chess*, *Chicago*, *Evita*, *Miss Saigon*, *My Fair Lady*, *West Side Story* and *Cats* to name a few, "Stars of the West End" features internationally-renowned stars of musical theatre **Mike Sterling**, **Shona Lindsay**, **Tom Solomon** and **Jayne O'Mahony**.

Mike Sterling has played the two most significant male lead roles in the West End: The Phantom in *The Phantom of the Opera* and Jean Valjean in *Les Misérables*. **Shona Lindsay** was the youngest actress in the world to play Christine in *The Phantom of the Opera*. She also starred as Sandy in *Grease* and Kathy Selden in *Singin' in the Rain*. **Tom Solomon** has played Mary Sunshine in *Chicago*, Raoul in *The Phantom of the Opera* and Marius in *Les Misérables*. He was winner of the BBC's prestigious Voice of Musical Theatre competition. **Jayne O'Mahony** created the role of young Cosette, aged nine, in the original production of *Les Misérables* at the Barbican and later returned to the production in the West End to play adult Cosette - the only actor ever to have achieved this. She also played The Mistress in *Evita*.
